Gilgit: Things to Do and See

Gilgit Valley is also considered as one of the finest valley of Pakistan. It is located at an elevation of 1454 meters. Gilgit is not only known for its beauty but also for a number of historic places that are worth-visiting. Some of the attractions in Gilgit Valley include:

- Budha Sculpture engraved out of stone
- Taj Mughal (30 KMs from Gilgit town)
- Sher Qilla
- Naltar Valley (at a three hours drive from Gilgit link road where you enjoy services of rest-house and various private hotels, alpine forest and a Ski slope)
- For those tourists who like to play and watch Polo, Gilgit is the best place to visit. A Polo tournament is held in Gilgit valley every year in the month of November.

Like other Northern valleys of Pakistan, Gilgit valley is also perfect of trout fishing, trekking, hiking and mountaineering.

Hunza: Things to Do and See

Hunza Valley is among one of the most popular valleys among tourists. Its major town Karimabad has some of the beautiful and elegant peaks in world including Rakaposhi, Passu Peak, Hunza Peak.
