Prospective bidders are required to submit their sealed quotation along with Rs. 5,000 as tender fee (Non Refundable) in the shape of pay order in favor of Pakistan International Airline.

Successful bidder will be required to submit PKR. 100,000 (Refundable) as deposit upon award of contract.

PIA reserve the right to annul tendering proceeding or extend opening date of the tender in line with the PPRA rules.
