

In-Flight Entertainment: M/s Panasonic (3000i) from Nose to Tail.

> Items to be installed:

Business Class: Used (Serviceable) Business Class lie flat bed seats, 2-3-2 abreast configuration.

Economy Class: New seats with a provision to accommodate standalone ISPS and PSS, this may be 3-3-3 or 3-4-3 abreast configuration.

In-Flight Entertainment: Installation of IFE system (seat and Head end) in Business Class and integration with Boeing systems along with revised Cabin Data Base (CDB).

Passenger Service System: PSS will be controlled via IFE in Business Class and standalone PSS to be installed in Economy Class. Nose-to-Tail PSS integration with Boeing system.

In-seat Power Charging: USB type ISPS will be available via IFE in Business Class and standalone ISPS in Economy Class (TYPE-A and TYPE-C).


